 - On Sunday January 17, 2010 the Bartlett Historical Society presented "A History of the Bartlett Ski Clubs". The evening began with about 40 people enjoying an Italian dinner and social hour hosted by the Innitou Ski Runners. We then moved down the street and joined many others at the Hickory Hawks Ski Club in the former Glen Junction train station. It was extremely well attended with standing room only.

 - The walls of the station were lined with displays by the various ski clubs and the Historical Society. Jeff Leich of the N.E. Ski Museum opened the event with a brief history of skiing in Bartlett and the impact that Bartlett had on the ski industry as a whole.

 - Each of Bartlett's thirteen ski clubs gave a short presentation. They spoke of the history of the club itself and of the building they called home. Each club was eager to point out its own bragging rights; whether it was the oldest, or largest, or that some of its members were Olympic skiers, or its members' contributions to skiing.
